

INTRODUCTION

Gender equality is when people of all genders have equal right, responsibilities and opportunities. everyone is affected by gender inequality – women, men trans and gender diverse people, children and families. It impacts people of all ages and background.

Women turnout during India's parliamentary general elections was 65.63 % compared to 67 .09% turnout for men. India rank 20th from the bottom in terms of representation of women in parliament.

Even in democratic societies in which gender equality is legally mandated, gender discrimination occurs in politics, both in regards to presumptions about political allegiances that fall along gender lines, and disparate gender representation within representative democracies. Historically, this was even more true when women were neither considered full citizens nor could not vote.

DEFINITION AND CONCEPT OF GENDER EQUALITY

Gender is a social – cultural term referring socially defined roles and behaviors assigned to 'males' and 'female' in a given society, whereas the term sex is a biologically and physiological phenomenon which defines men and women in its social, historical and cultural aspects, gender is a function of power relationship between men and women. Therefore, gender may be understood as a man – made concept, while 'sex' is natural or biological characteristics of human beings.

Gender equality in simple words, may be defined as discrimination against women based on their sex. Women are traditionally considered by the society as weaker sex. She has been accorded a subordinate position to men. She is exploited degraded, violated and discriminated.

IMPORTANCE OF GENDER EUALITY IN POLITICS

- Equal participation of women and men in politics is an important condition for effective democracy and good governance. Apart from strengthening and enhancing the democratic system, the participation of more women in political decision – making has many positive effects on society that can help improve the lives of women and men. The programme was well organized and appreciated by the participants and faculty of godavari college of nursing, Jalgaon.





The full and equitable participation of women in public life is essential to building and sustaining strong, vibrant democracies.

There is growing recognition of the untapped capacity and talents of women and women's leadership. Over the last two decades, the <u>rate of women's representation</u> in national parliaments globally has incrementally increased from 11.8 percent in 1998 to 17.8 percent in 2008 to 23.5 percent in 2018. Some regions have seen particularly dramatic increase, such as Sub-Saharan Africa, where in last 20 years the number of women in parliaments has risen from 11 to 23.6 percent, and the Arab States region, which has seen an increase from 3.1 to 17.5 percent. Total global representation is still well below the 30 percent benchmark often identified as the necessary level of representation to achieve a "critical mass" – a considerable minority of all legislators with significant impact, rather than a token few individuals – not to mention falling short of women's representation as half of the world's population.

Accordingly, the meaningful participation of women in national, local, and community leadership roles has become an important focus for global development policy.

Women's participation in politics helps advance gender equality and affects both the range of policy issues that get considered and the types of solutions that are proposed. <u>Research indicates</u> that whether a legislator is male or female has a distinct impact on their policy priorities. There is also strong evidence that as more women are elected to office, there is a corollary increase in policy making that emphasizes quality of life and reflects the priorities of families, women, and ethnic and racial minorities.

DESCRIPTION:

Essay writing is not just a method of academic assessment, but also an art. This is an art of reporting and describing about a topic. It not only requires storytelling skills, but also the presentation of the story. With our essay writing competition, we want to discover essay writing talent from the students.

- ✤ Essays must be written by one person. Co-authored essays are not accepted.

- ✤ Originality and word limit (10 marks)
- ✤ Insights and clarity of thoughts (10 marks)
- ✤ Creativity, unity and consistency (10 marks)

JUDGEMENT CRITERIA:-

The essays will be judged by a committee of college.
